WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement on the 23rd day of July, 2019, whereby the "CONTRACTOR" shall provide Children and Youth Mental Health services to the COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the parties hereto now desire to modify the term of said agreement; NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and before the parties hereto as follows:

EXHIBIT C

FISCAL PROVISIONS

1. Payments:

d. During the months of the COVID-19 crisis, March- June 2020, CONTRACTOR may be eligible for a minimum relief payment not to exceed the average monthly payment provided from July 1, 2019 – February 29, 2020.

In order to be eligible for an average monthly payment as a result of the COVID-19 crisis, the CONTRACTOR must demonstrate that the services indicated in Exhibit A, as well as COVID-19 essential activities, were offered during the month. The CONTRACTOR will submit standard documentation of monthly activities in accordance with the Scope of Work. The COUNTY will review units of service, personnel and operating costs that indicate the CONTRACTOR maintained operations and managed cost. If the CONTRACTOR submits documentation demonstrating units of service that indicate payment above the minimum relief payment (average monthly payment), the CONTRACTOR is entitled to the standard reimbursement accorded by this Exhibit. The CONTRACTOR will submit an annual financial statement within ninety (90) days after the end of the fiscal year including a report of the final adjustment to actual cost, including FEMA/COVID-19 Disaster Relief funds or grants received.

In all other respects except as herein modified, the Agreement dated <u>July 23, 2019,</u> including but not limited to Exhibit C shall remain unchanged.
